

Segway Adventure Trek – Delivery Plan 2020/21



Three variables in transmission:

- Droplets - duration & proximity
- Fomite – handling equipment
- Population – number of participants (including risk factors for those with underlying health conditions)

Duration & Proximity

- All instructors will wear masks/visors at all times
- One Segway session run per day with a max of 5 riders per session
- Self-declaration of no symptoms by all riders (on sign in sheet)
- Riders and spectators asked to wear masks
- Social distancing tape at check in station
- Social distancing posters up at container and Segway site and instructors to remind riders regularly to social distance
- Riders to be warned that instructors may have to break social distancing for safety reasons or to administer first aid (masks must be worn and instructors are advised to sanitise hands after administering first aid and to not touch face)

Handling of Equipment

- Separate sign in sheet and pen for each rider
- Placed in basket and not handled for 72 hours
- Payment is taken in advance (avoiding the handling of money)
- Gloves to be worn by instructors whilst setting up Segways
- Hand sanitiser available on check in and at Segway site
- Rigorous cleaning of Segways and helmets after each session
- Personal hygiene – instructors encourage to hand sanitise regularly, to change out of uniform as soon as possible and wash uniform in between sessions, cough/sneeze into sleeve, don't touch face etc
- Instructors helping to put riders onto machines must sanitise hands between helping each rider to avoid cross contamination
- Instructors are equipped with first aid kit, personal hand sanitiser and spare masks

Number of Participants/Spectators

- In accordance with government guidelines treks are limited to 5 people with one instructor max
- Rule of six applies with upto 6 people from 2 households
- Spectators are not encouraged but should sign in, make a self-declaration, wear a face mask at all times on site and use hand sanitiser. Clear explanation of wear they need to stand (social distancing)
- On booking (online calendar) customers are asked if there are any medical conditions we should know about before the trek and adjustments made accordingly
